



INTRODUCTION

In the Month of April and May, Hennet has partnered with other like-minded organizations and media for advocacy on vaccine stock outs in Kenya. Ahead of the Immunization Week 2024, a HENNET member brought to attention the matter of county vaccine stockouts. On further interrogation from community reports on the same CSOs under the leadership of HENNET identified similar stockout cases in Seven Counties Siaya, Kisumu, Kitui, Kakamega, Taita-Taveta, Kajiado, Baringo. Speaking with a contact from FCDC Kenya office, HENNET also confirmed cases of measles in Garissa. These findings in turn led HENNET to constitute a small team of partners who then collectively embarked on an advocacy campaign to address the issues.



Follow up virtual meetings to outline the follow-up measures on the matter are being conducted.
