The Health NGOs Network (HENNET), with support from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation is pleased to announce a call for proposals for a sub-grant to support advocacy activities focusing on Primary Health Care (PHC) including Maternal, Child Health as part of the PHC Coalition initiative. This funding opportunity includes a cost-sharing requirement, where applicants are expected to contribute a portion of the project costs through cash, in-kind contributions, or other resources.

### **Purpose**

This sub-grant aims to enhance and support innovative, impactful, and sustainable PHC advocacy activities that contribute to strengthening health systems and improving health outcomes.

### **Eligibility**

Eligible applicants must be registered NGOs, CBOs, or non-profit organizations and registered members of HENNET with a proven track record in implementing Health advocacy projects at county level

3. Health and community Systems Strengthening Advocacy
4. Disease Prevention and Health Promotion Advocacy

6. Innovative PHC Advocacy Solutions
